

NUTRITION INVESTMENT SNAPSHOT: PERU



SUMMARY TABLE

Peru's budgetary structure is aggregated at the programme level. This means that each budget line item represents a programme. With this information, the 2016 analysis identifies 55 nutrition-relevant programmes. The 55 nutrition relevant-programmes received 78.03 per capita in allocations in 2014 (all estimates in USD).

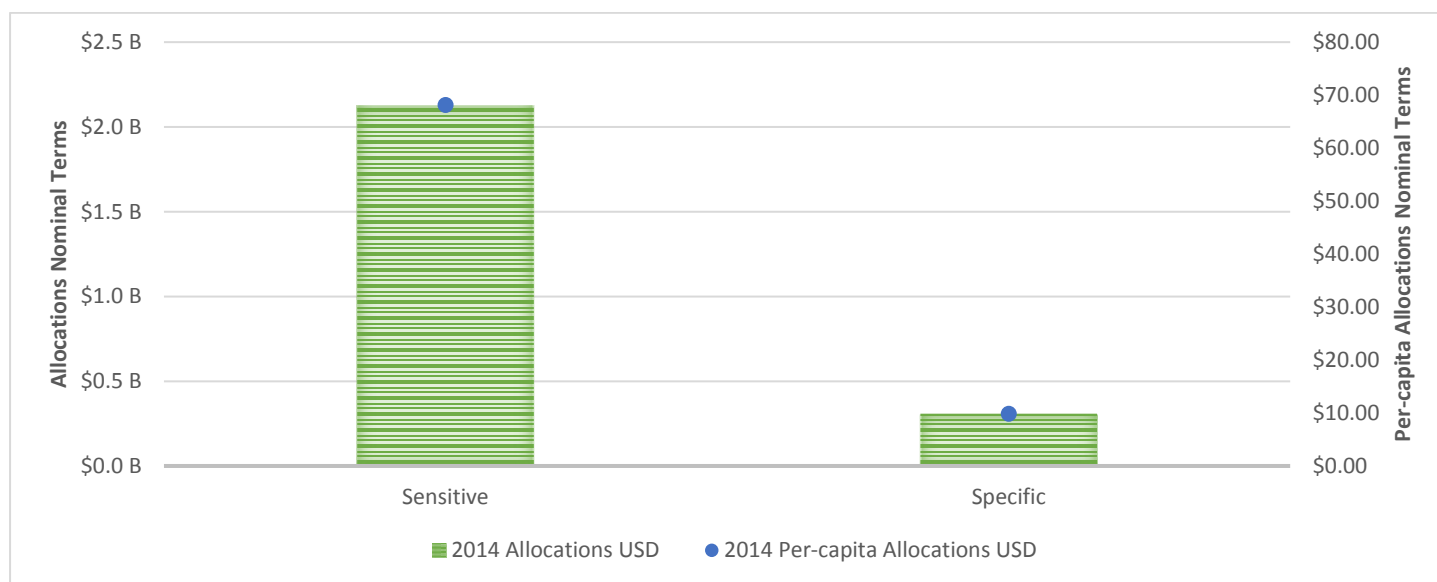

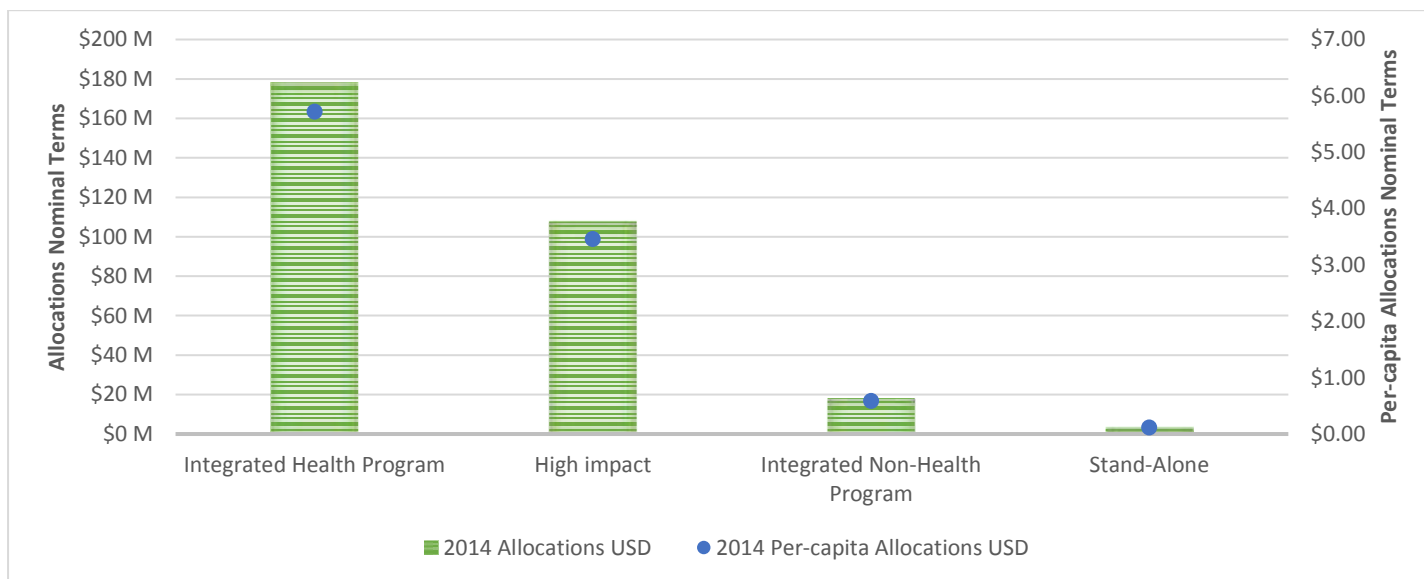

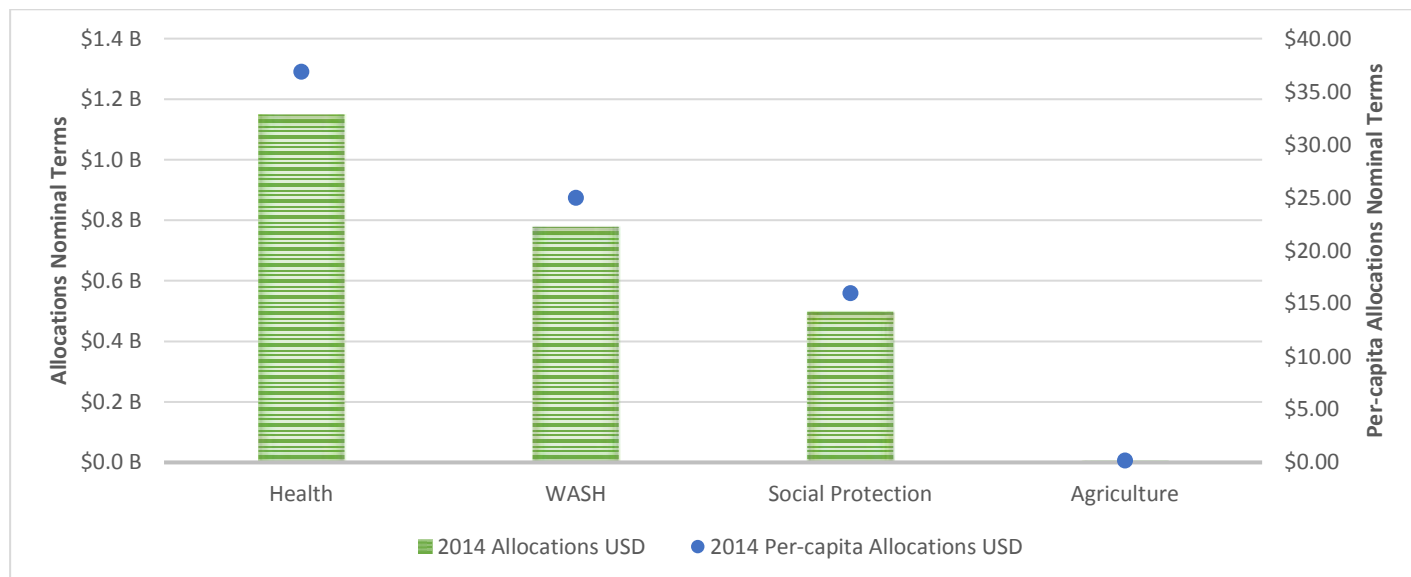

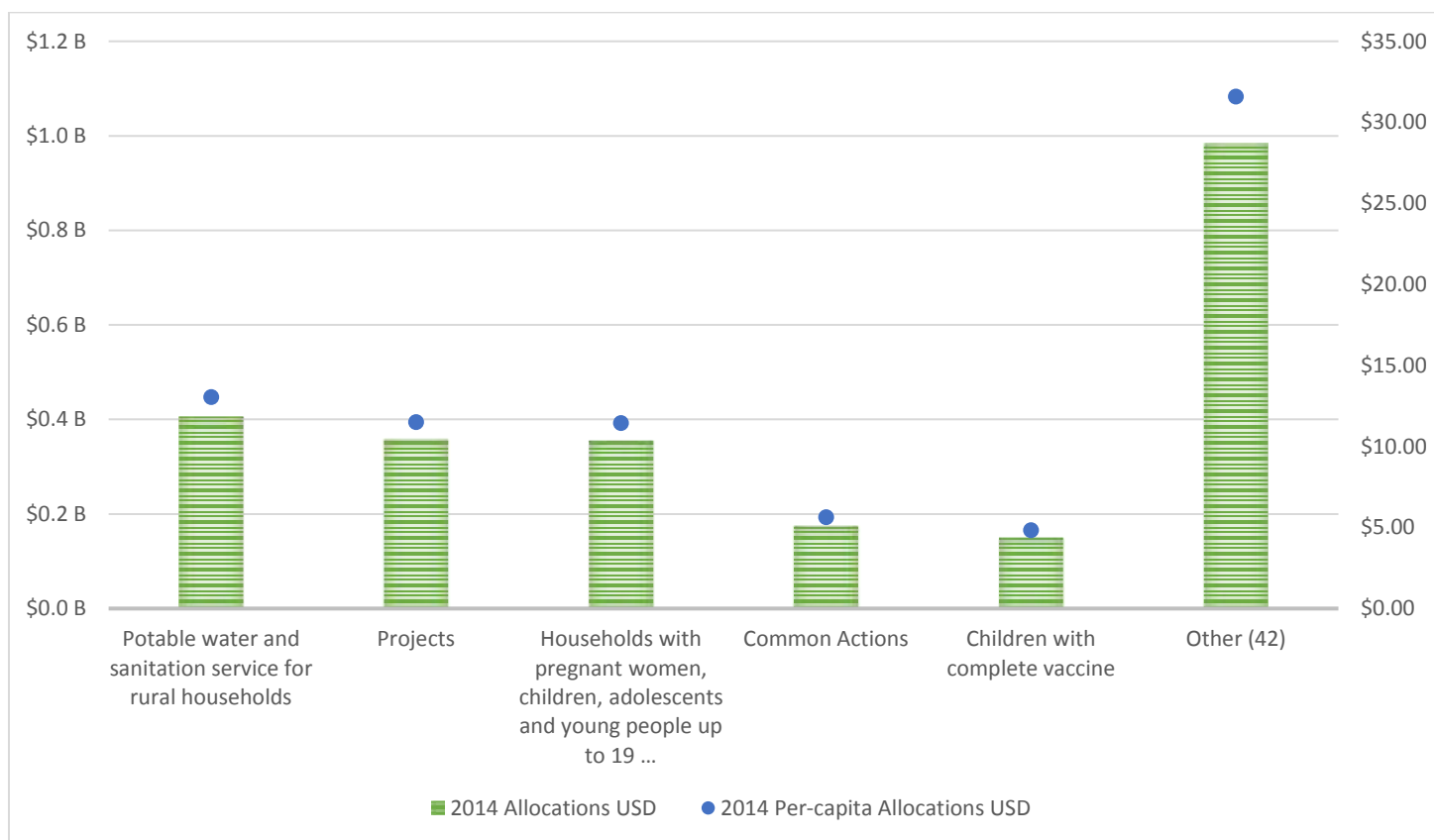
