

NUTRITION INVESTMENT SNAPSHOT: UGANDA



59 countries are leading a global movement to end malnutrition in all its forms.

SUMMARY TABLE

Uganda's budgetary structure is aggregated at the programme level. This means that each budget line item represents a programme. With this information, the 2016 analysis by Uganda identifies 42 programmes in 2013-2014. The 42 nutrition-relevant programmes are overseen by six ministries, departments and agencies (MDA's), which allocated 0.53 per capita in 2013 (all estimates are in USD).

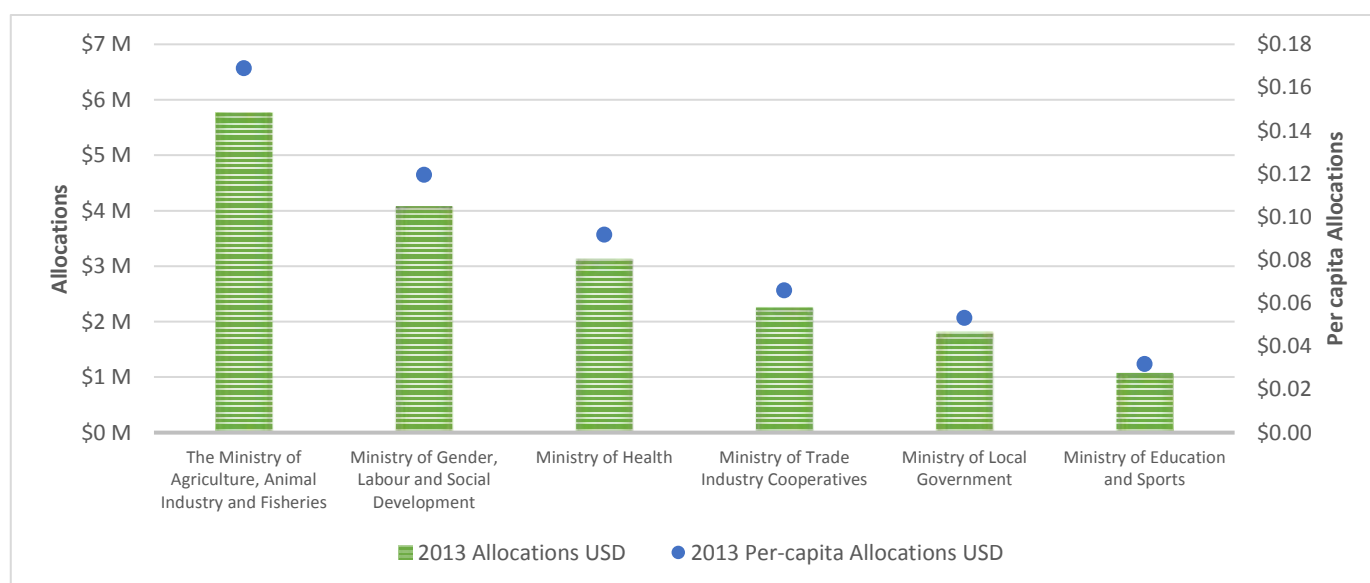

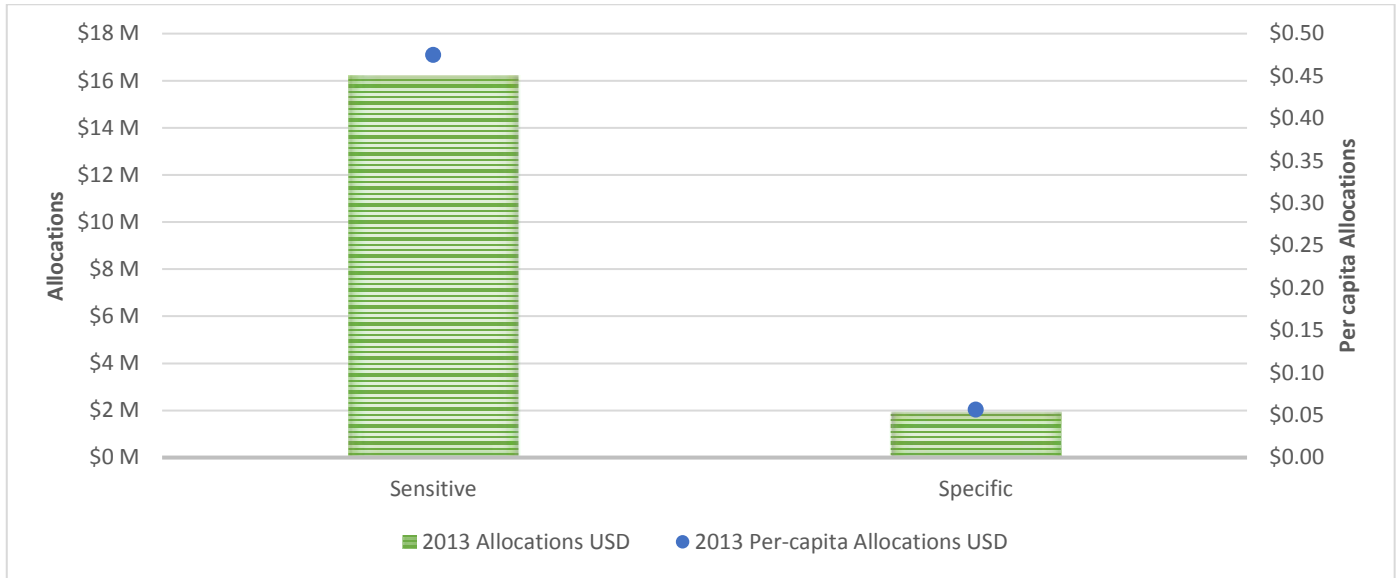

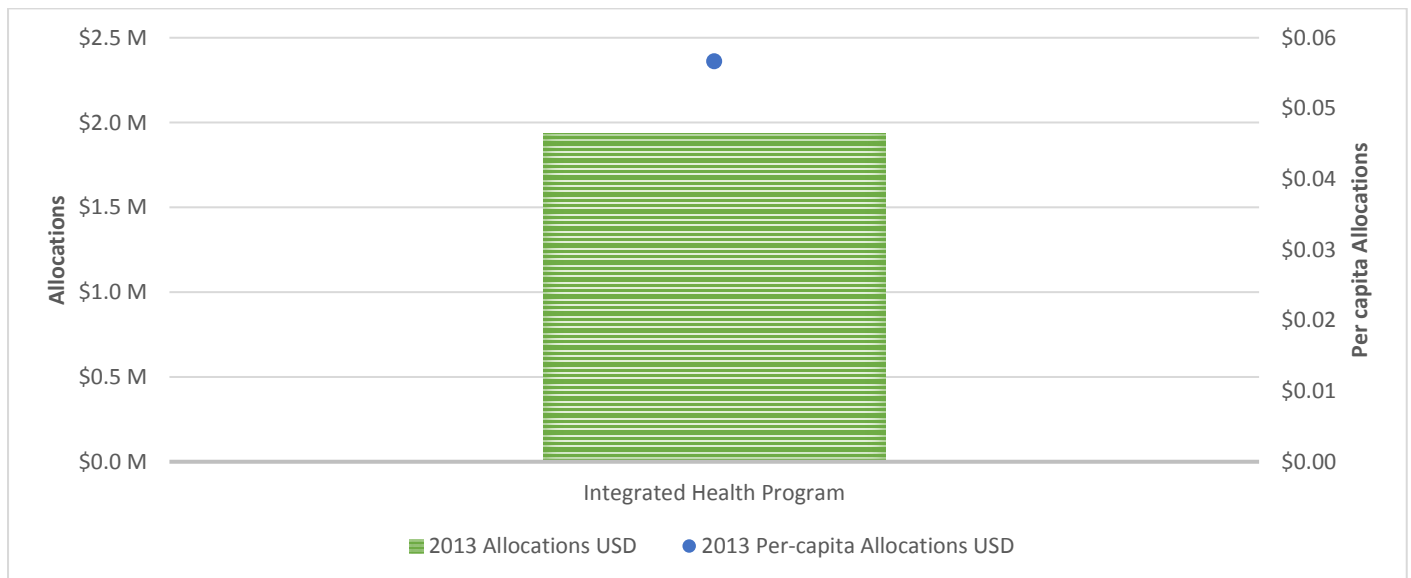

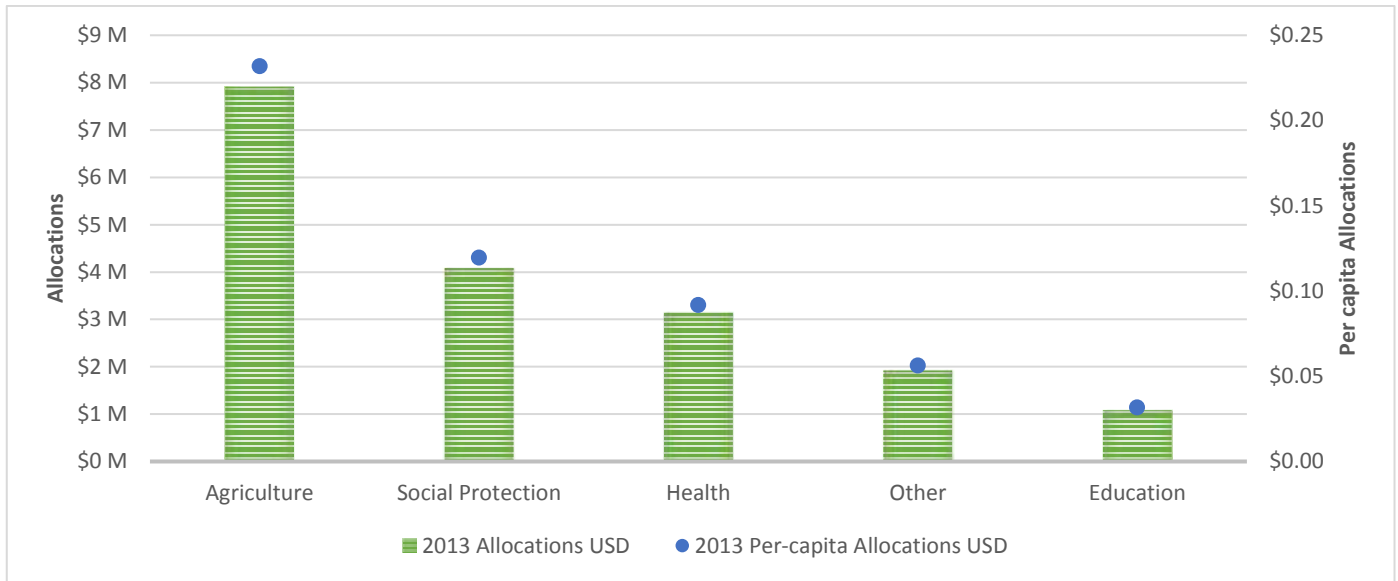

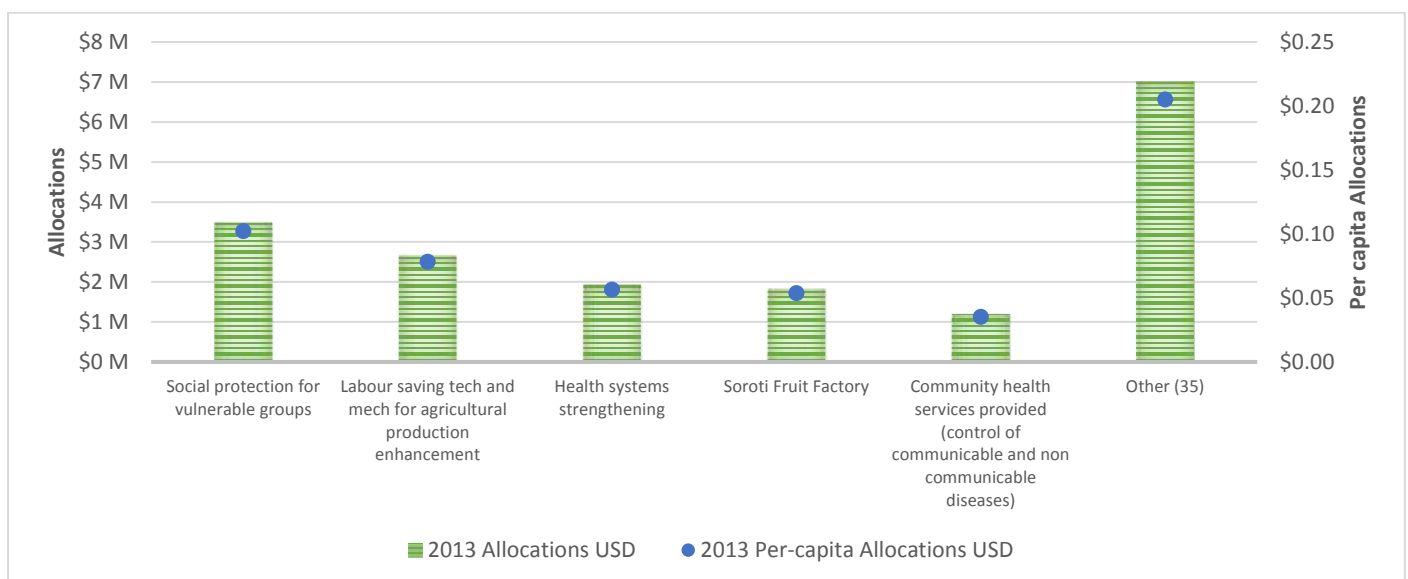
