SUMMARY TABLE

Congo's budgetary structure is aggregated at the programme level. This means that each budget line item represents a programme. With this information, the 2016 analysis identifies 19 nutrition-relevant programmes. The 19 nutrition-relevant programmes are overseen by eight ministries, departments or agencies (MDAs), which allocated 24.60 per capita in 2014 (all estimates in USD).

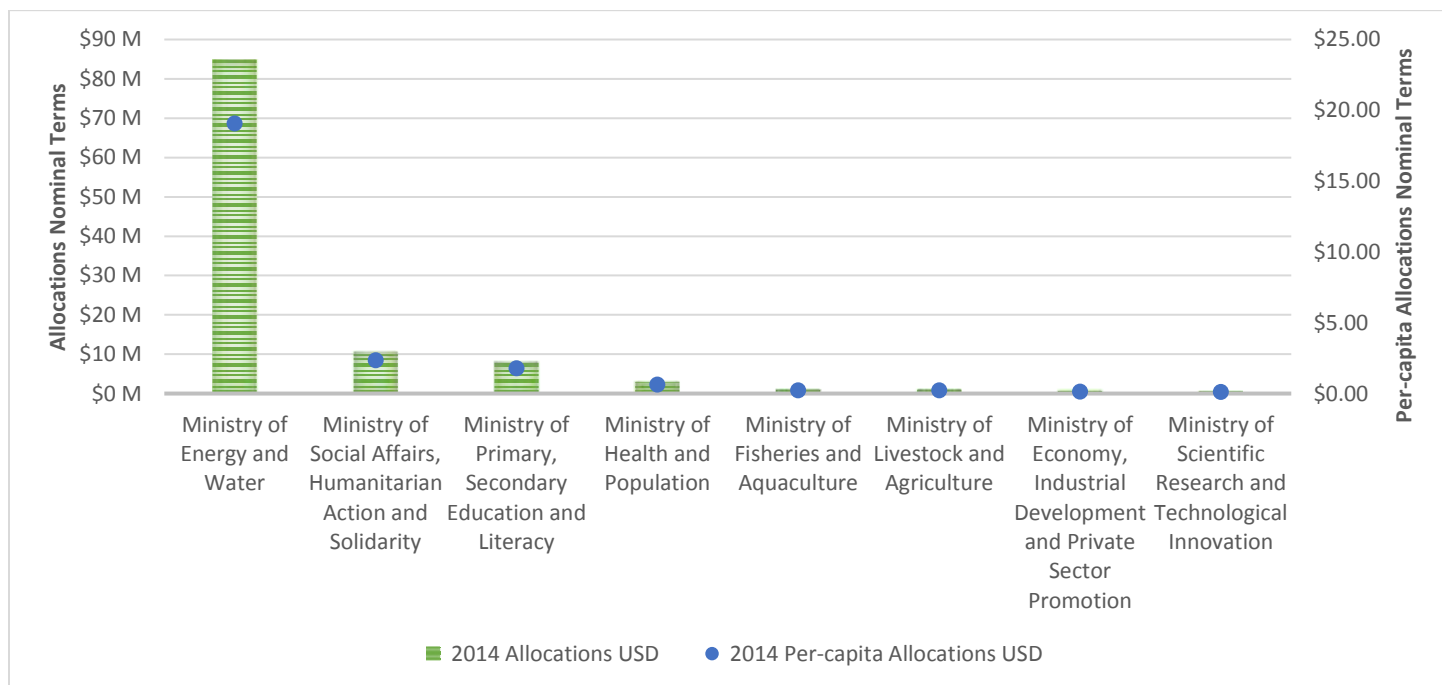
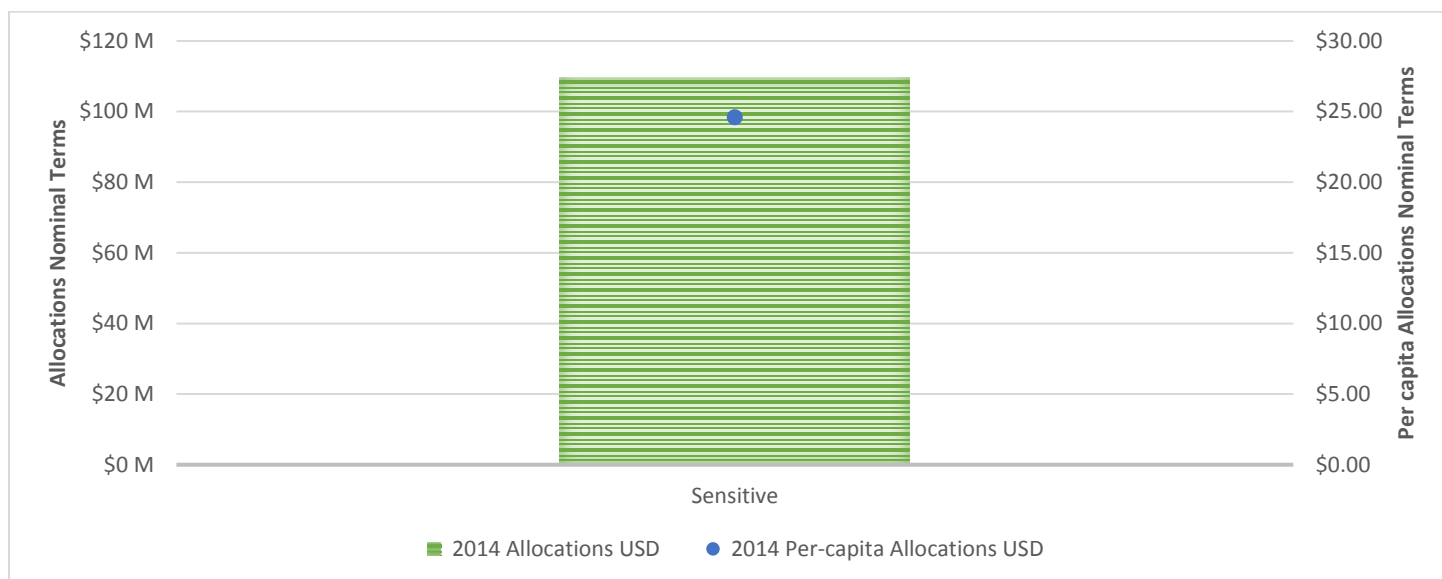

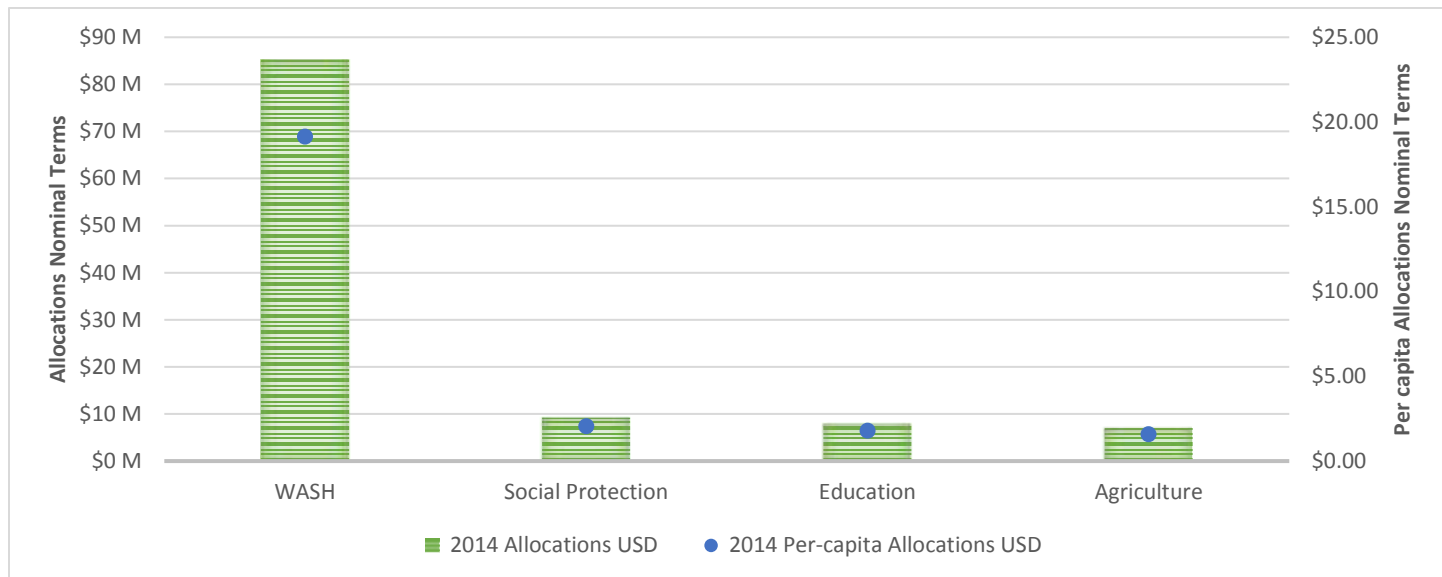

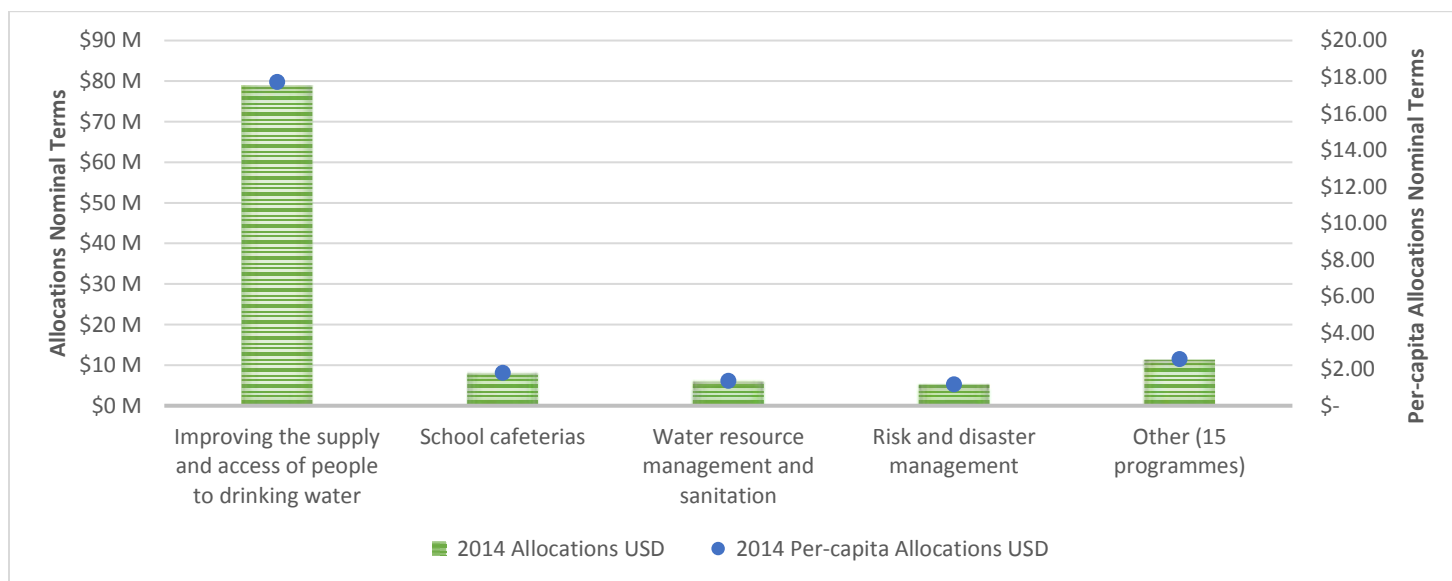
