59 countries are leading a global movement to end malnutrition in all its forms.

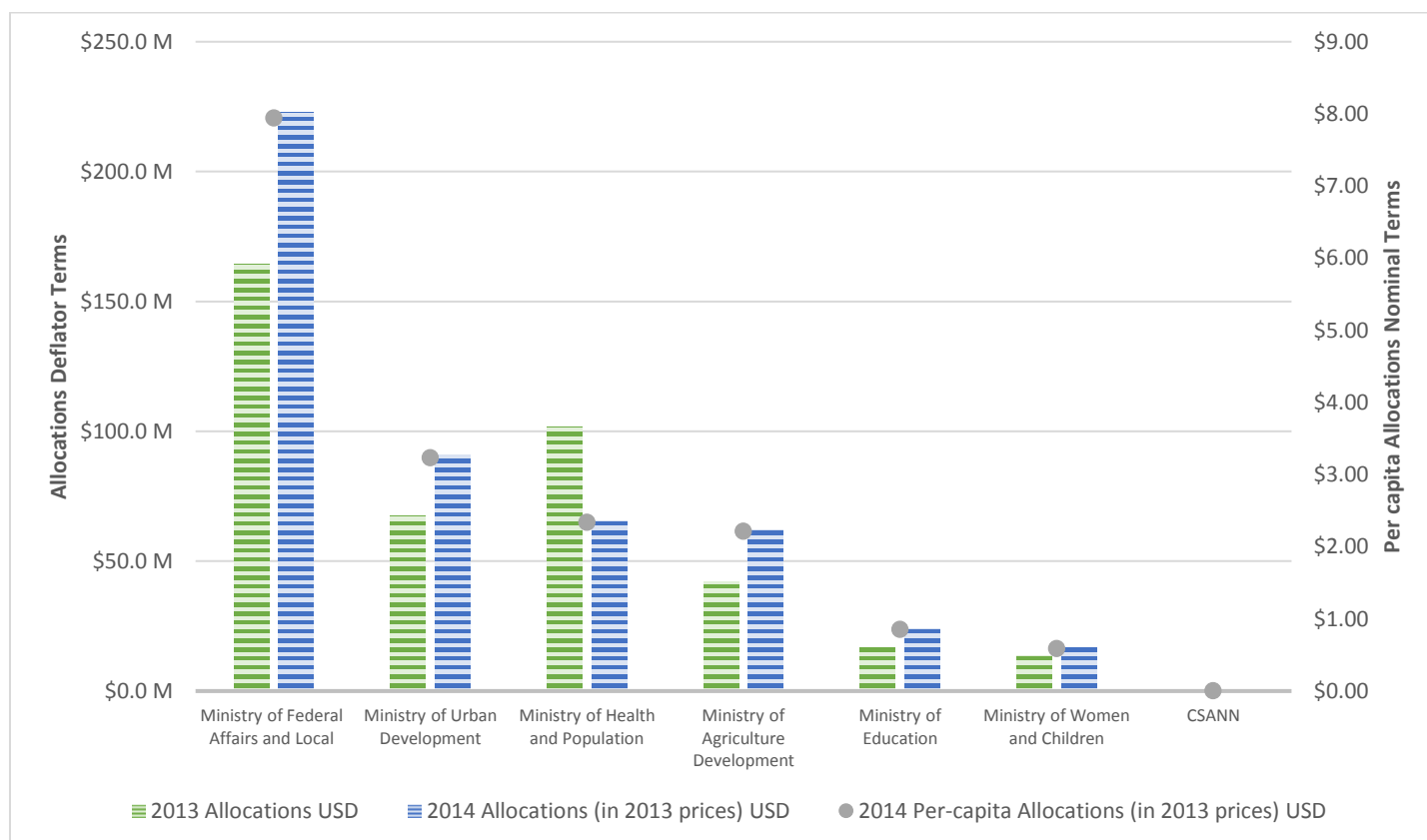
## SUMMARY TABLE

Nepal's budgetary structure is aggregated at the programme level. This means that each budget line item represents a programme. With this information, the 2016 analysis identifies 57 nutrition-relevant programmes which received allocations in 2014. The 33 nutrition-relevant programmes are overseen by thirteen Ministries, Departments and Agencies (MDAs), which allocated USD 10.49 per capita in 2014 (all estimates in USD).

## Trends in upper-bound nutrition-relevant allocations across MDAs, 2013 vs. 2014 (USD)

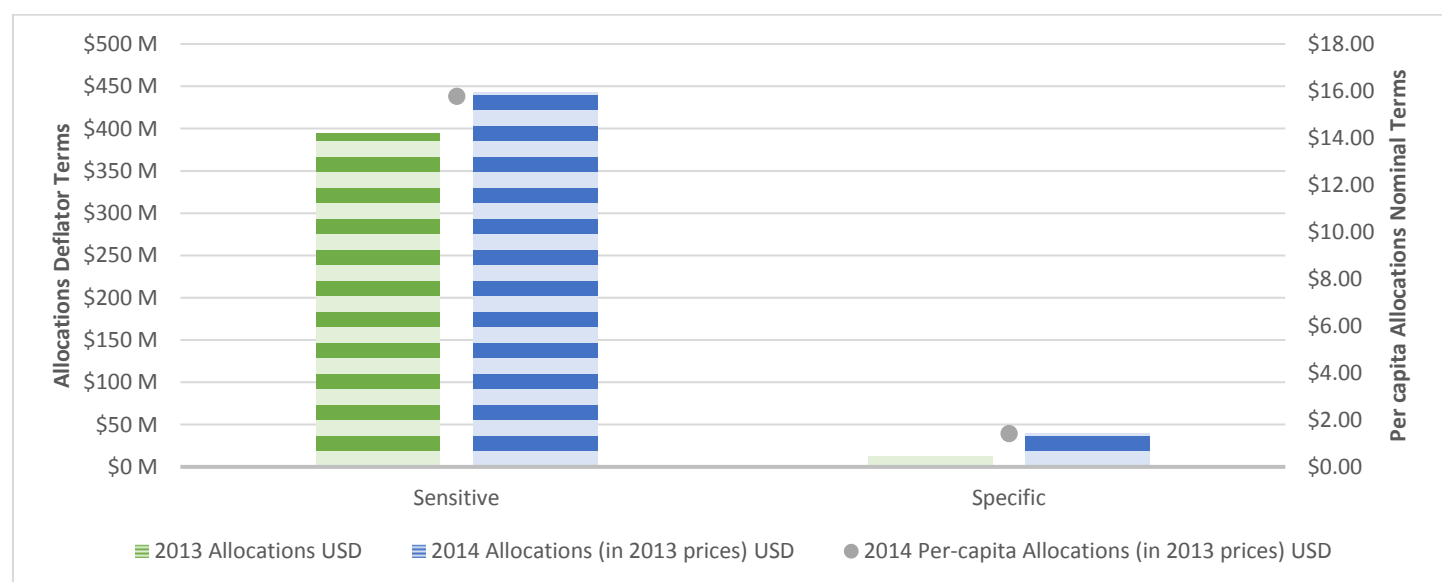

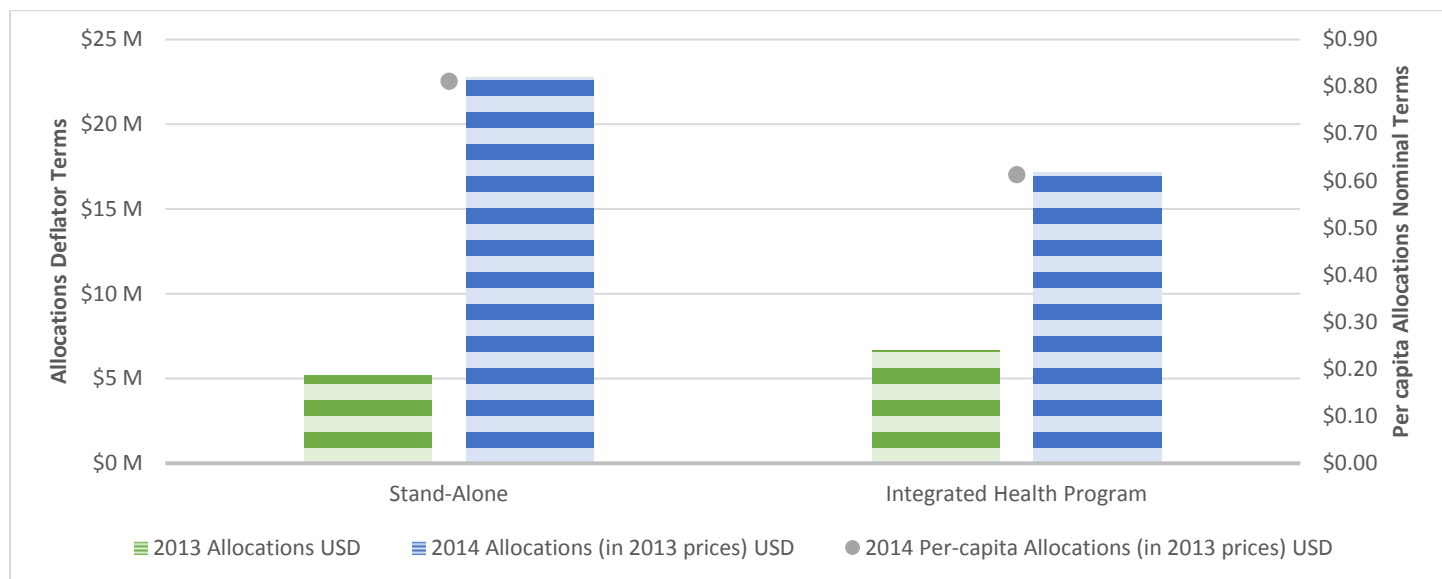

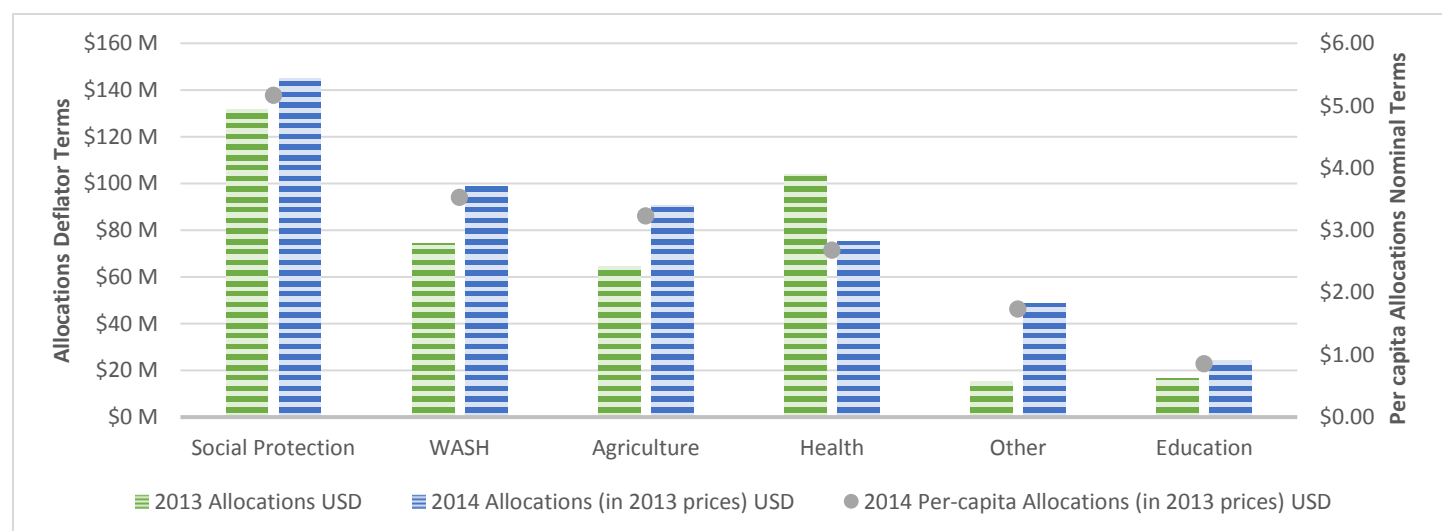

## Trends in upper-bound sectoral budget allocations, 2013 vs. 2014 (USD)

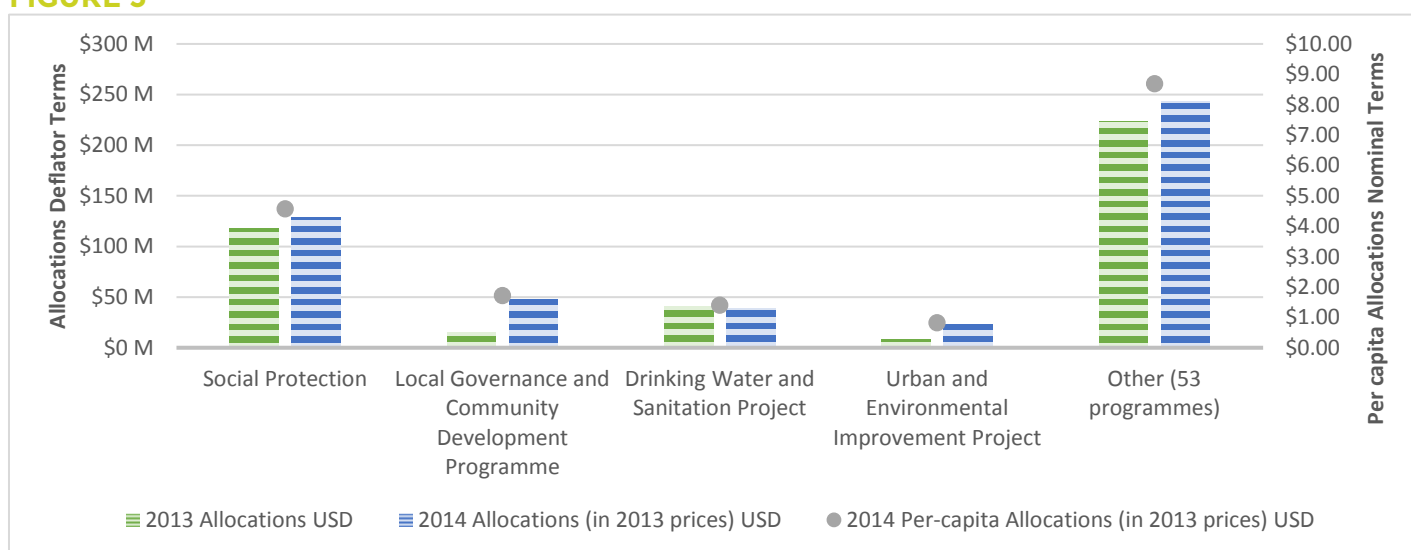
