

# NUTRITION INVESTMENT SNAPSHOT: ZAMBIA



59 countries are leading a global movement to end malnutrition in all its forms.

## SUMMARY TABLE

Zambia's budgetary structure is aggregated at the programme level. This means that each budget line item represents a programme. With this information, the 2016 analysis identifies 19 nutrition-relevant programmes in 2014. The 19 nutrition-relevant programmes are overseen by three ministries, departments and agencies (MDA's), which allocated 2.21 per capita in 2014 (all estimates in USD).

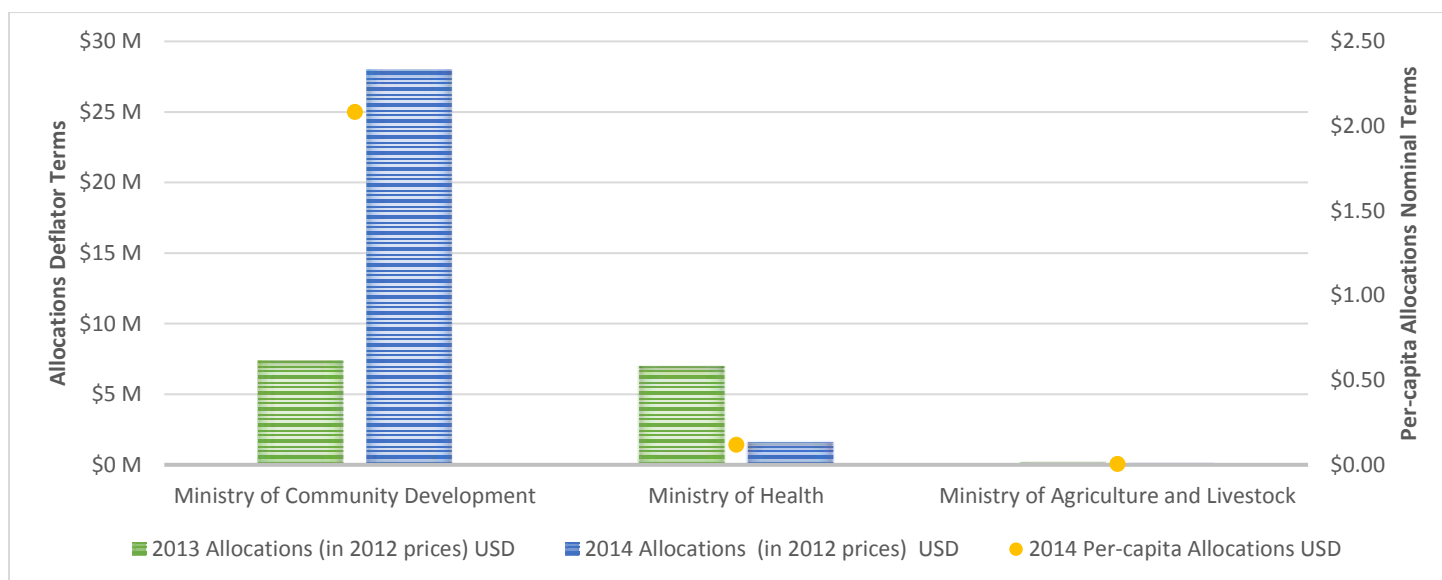

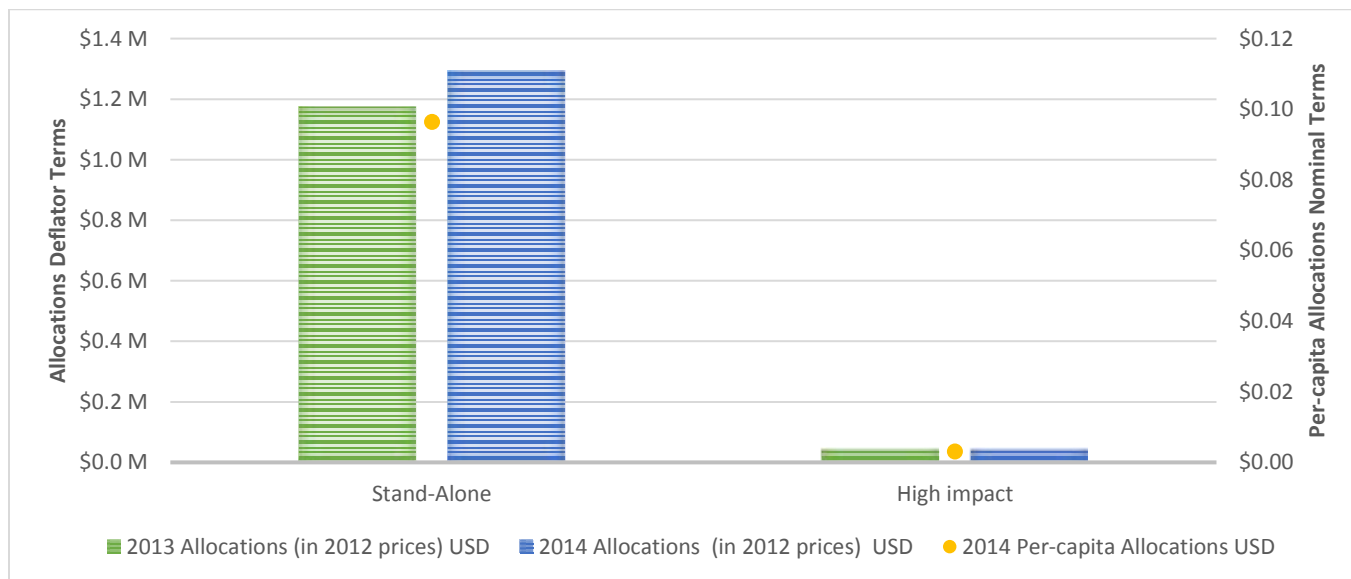

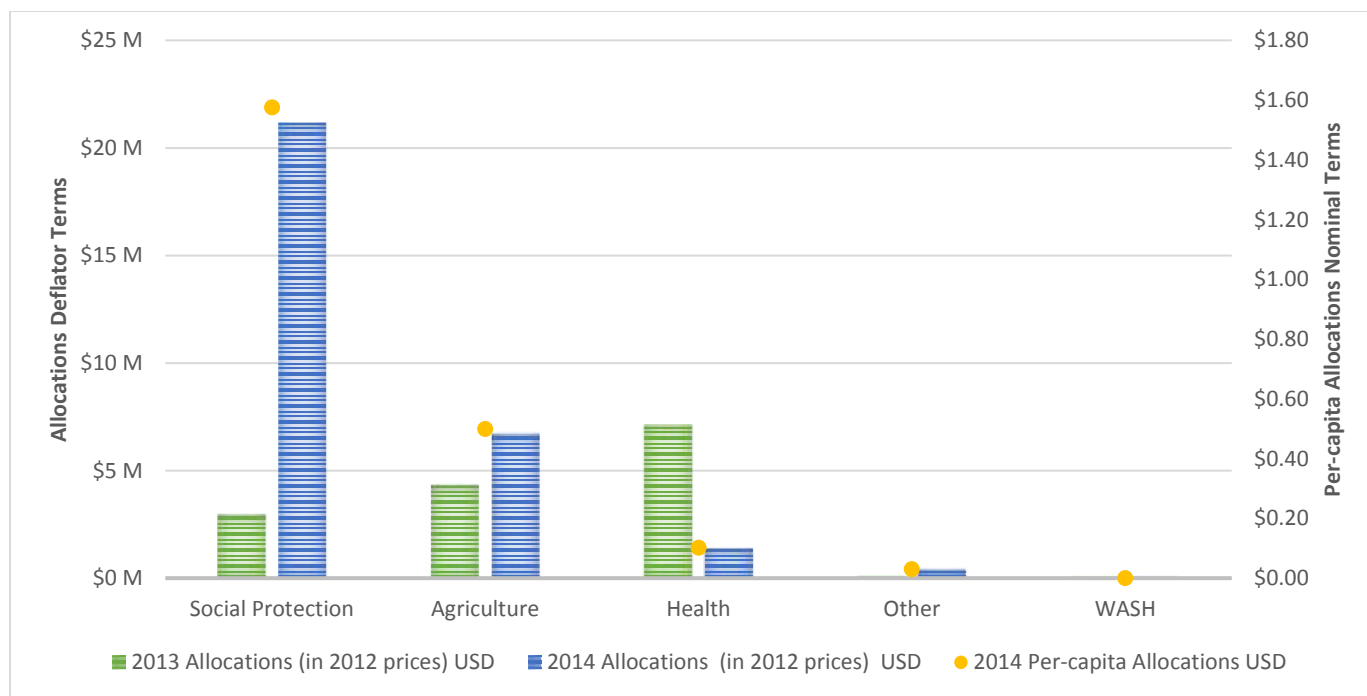

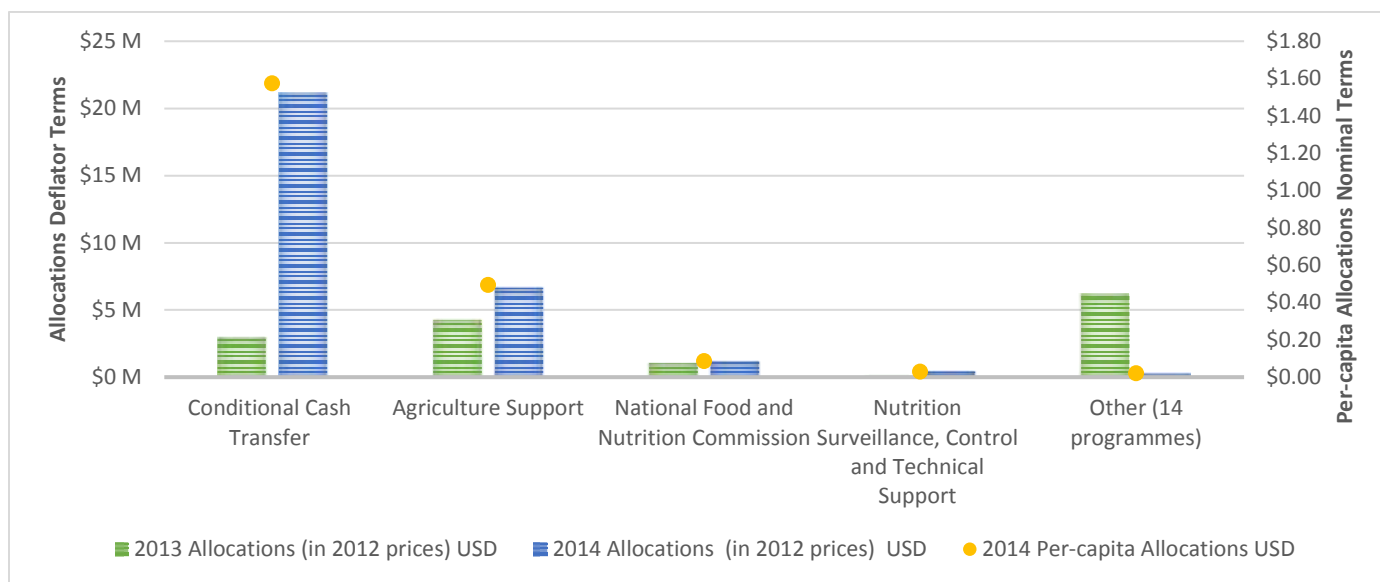
