
#### **SUMMARY TABLE**

Viet Nam's budgetary structure is aggregated at the programme level. This means that each budget line item represents a programme. With this information, the 2018 analysis by Vietnam identifies 54 budget-line items relating to 38 nutrition-relevant programmes managed by four identified ministries, departments and agencies (MDA's), six non-governmental organisations, and three international organizations, which totalled 1.87 per-capita in 2016 (all estimates in USD).








