Mauritania



60 countries are leading a global movement to end malnutrition in all its forms.

SUMMARY TABLE

Mauritania's budgetary structure is aggregated at the programme level. This means that for each programme, there is more than one budget line. With this information, the 2020 budget analysis identifies 89 nutrition-relevant programmes, of which 58 programmes received allocations in 2020. The 58 programmes are overseen by a total of fourteen ministries, departments or agencies which allocated \$31.52 USD in 2020 (all estimates in USD).

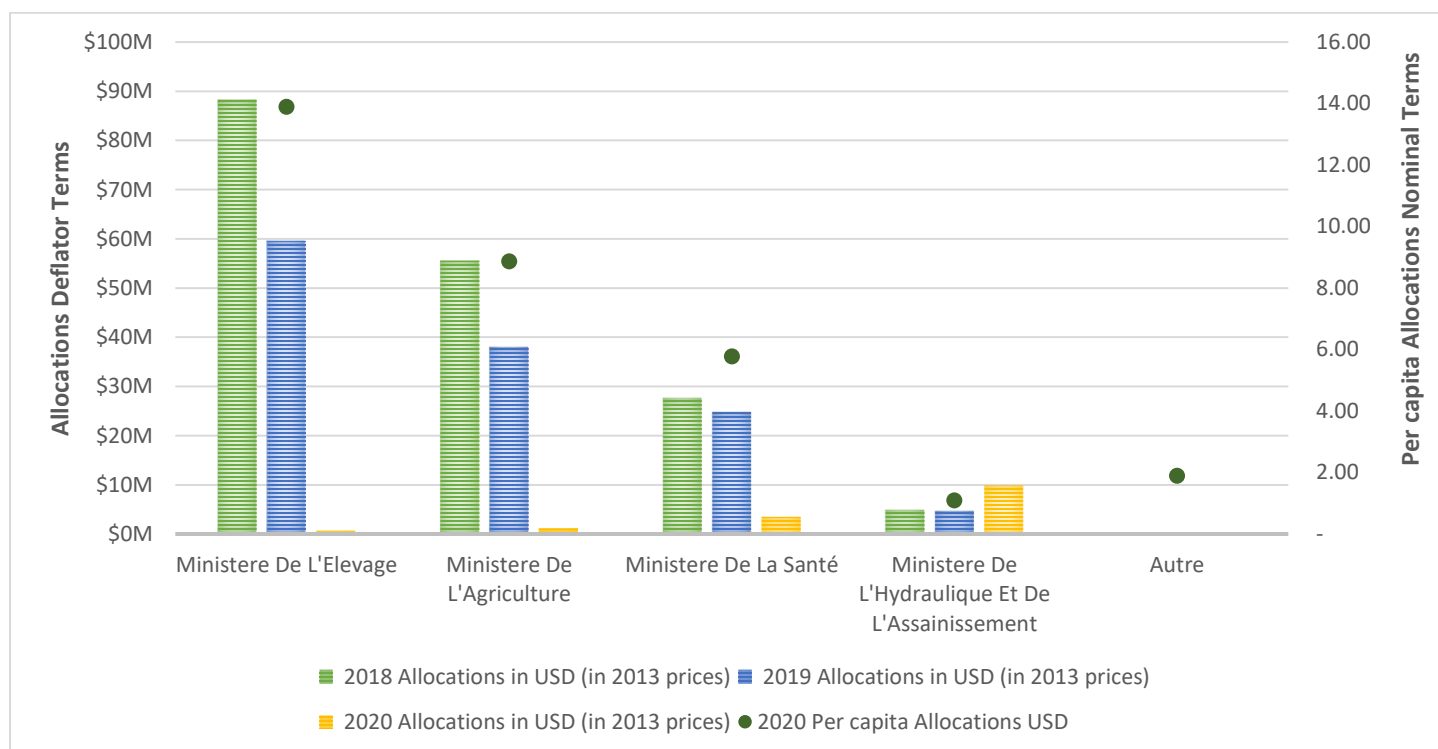
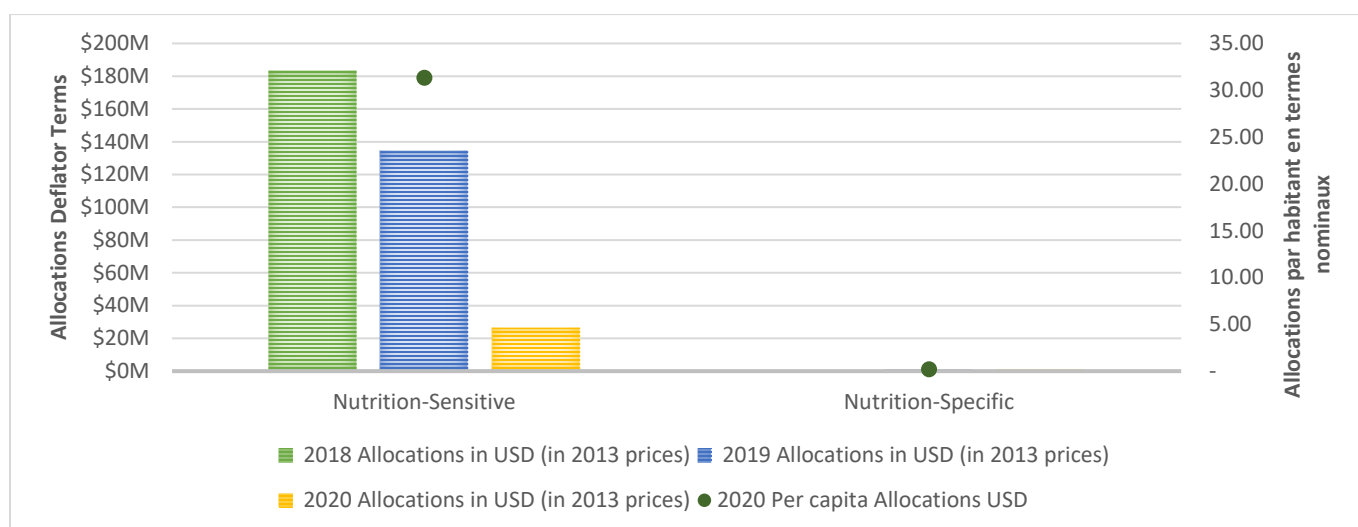

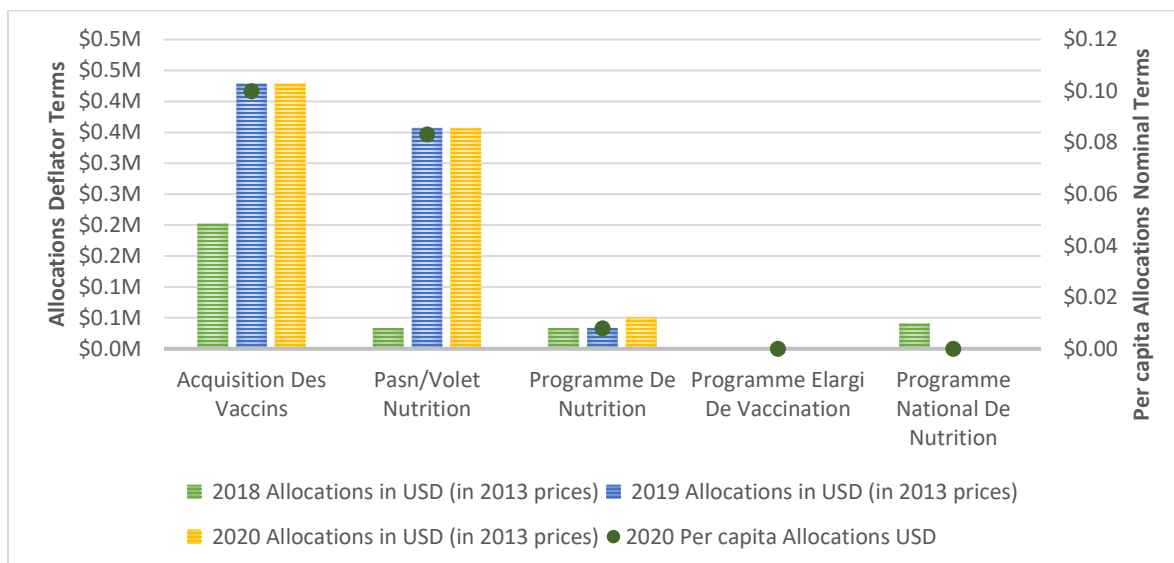

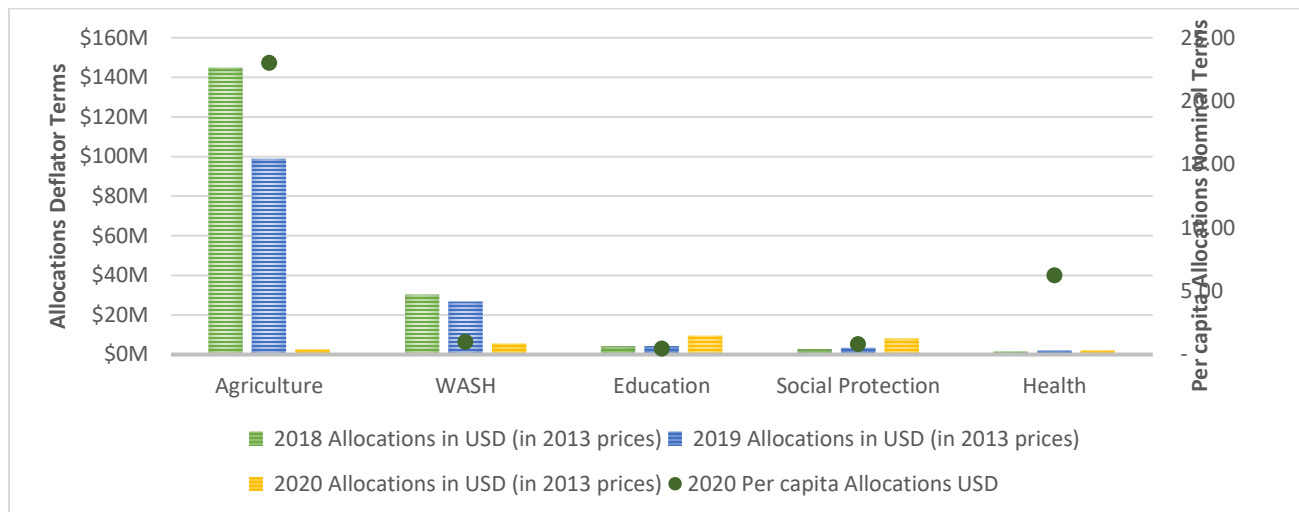
