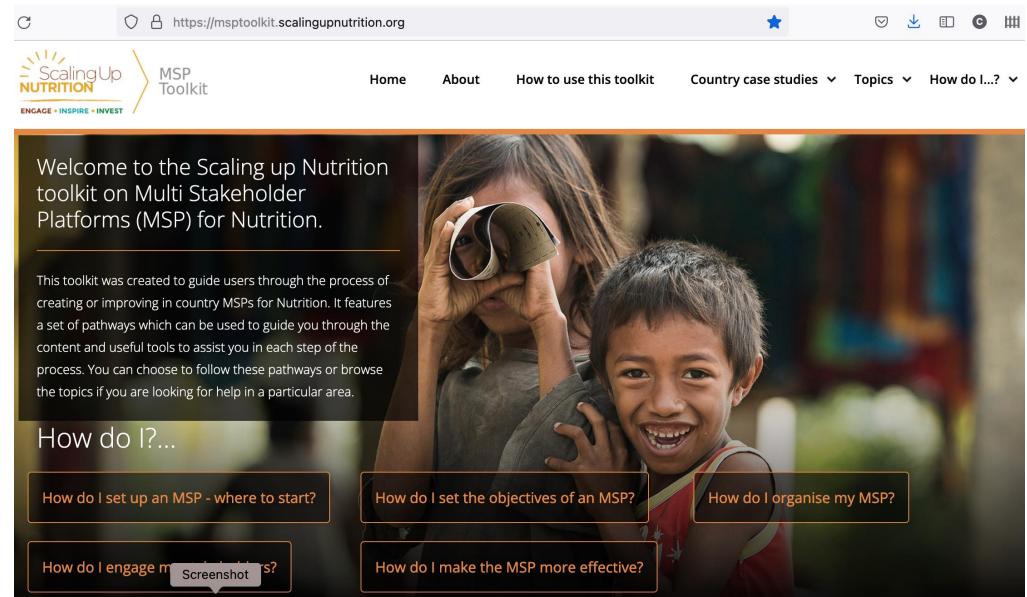

Overview

- Responds to need for TA on managing intersectoral coordination
 - Development led by Institute of Development Studies, UK
- Uses multiple sources of existing materials, including:
 - The MSP Guide from Wageningen University
 - FANTA's multi-sectoral nutrition toolkit for Uganda
- Guides process of creating or improving an MSP for Nutrition
 - 30 issue guides: definitions, explanations, practical tools and guides
 - 5 country case studies of countries
- Currently only in English, but translation into French possible
