- → SO.2 Develop and align shared country priorities for action The SUN Business Network has prepared a proposal to improve the processing and packaging of locally produced foods in the country in order to meet global standards. The proposal has already been approved.
- SO.3 Build and strengthen country capacity According to UNICEF, funds already have been budgeted for the procurement of therapeutic food.
