89 countries are leading a global movement to end malnutrition in all its forms.

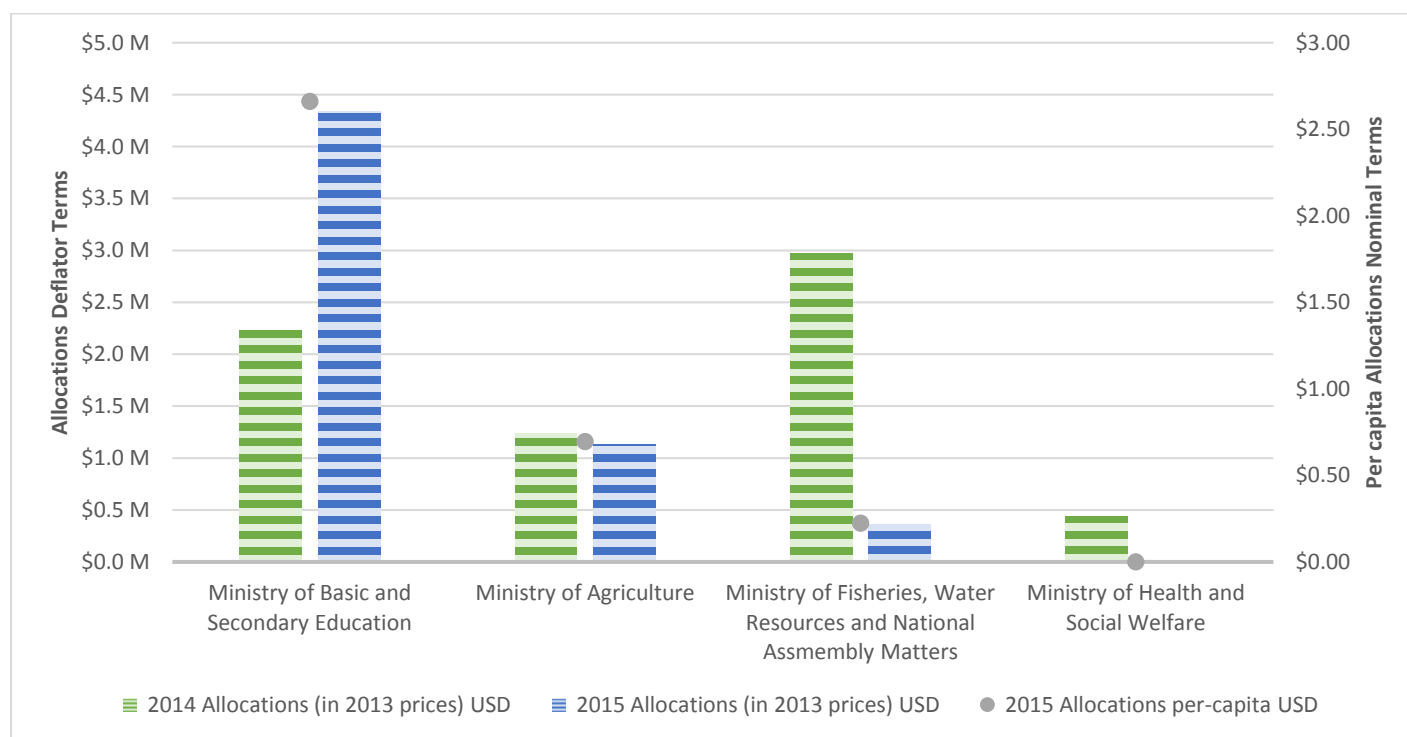
SUMMARY TABLE

The Gambia's budgetary structure is aggregated at the programme level. This means that each budget line item represents a programme. With this information, the 2016 analysis identifies 32 nutrition relevant programmes, of which 7 programmes received allocations in 2015. The 7 nutrition-relevant programmes are overseen by four ministries, departments and agencies (MDAs), which allocated 3.96 per-capita in 2015¹ (all estimates in USD).

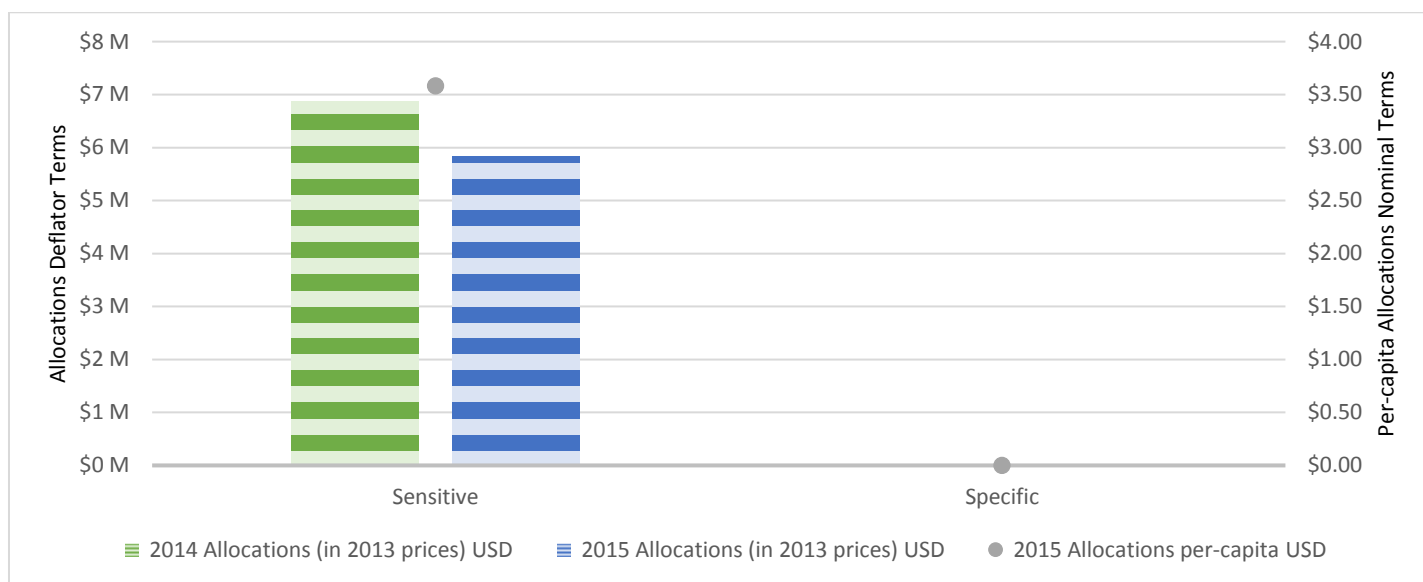

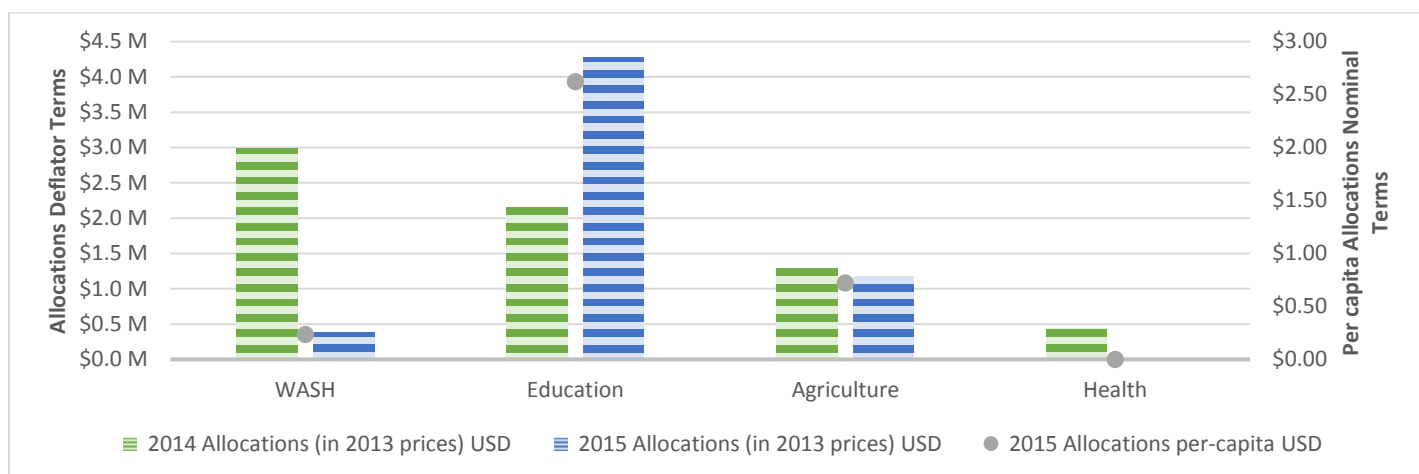

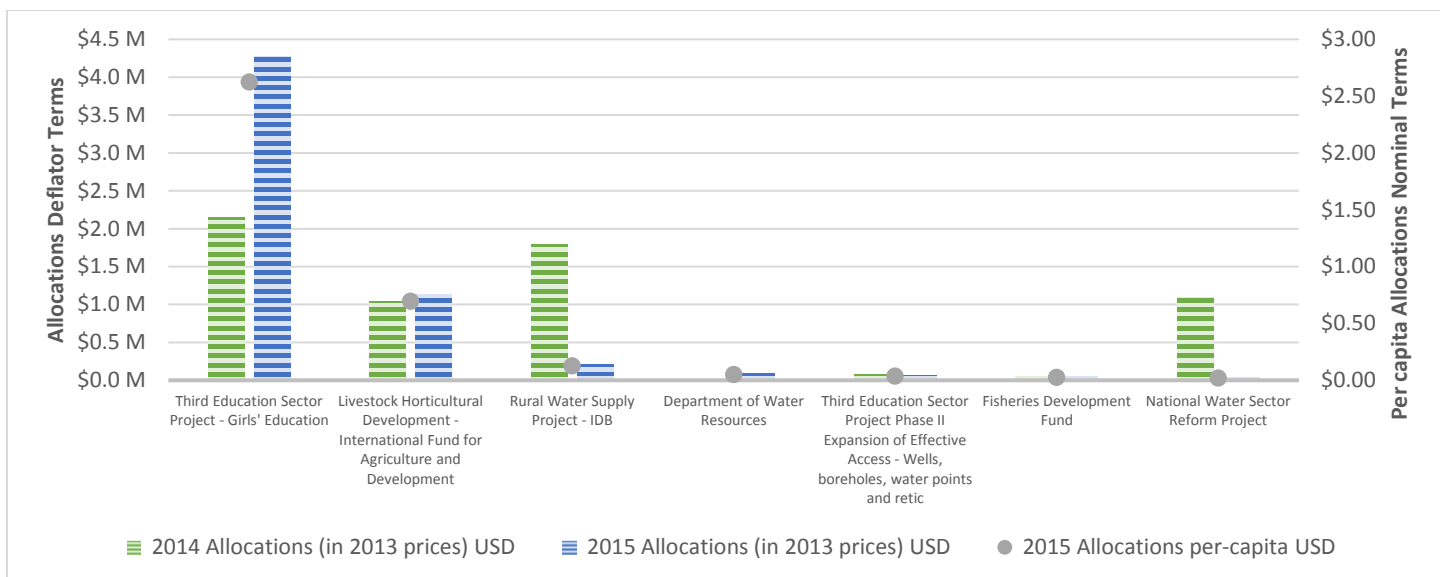
