

SUMMARY TABLE

Nigeria's budgetary structure is aggregated at the programme level. This means that each budget line item represents a programme. With this information, the 2018 analysis by Nigeria identifies 283 budget-line items, of which 181 received allocations in 2015. The 181 nutrition-relevant programmes are managed by five identified ministries, departments and agencies (MDA's), which totalled \$0.40 per-capita in 2015 (all estimates in USD).

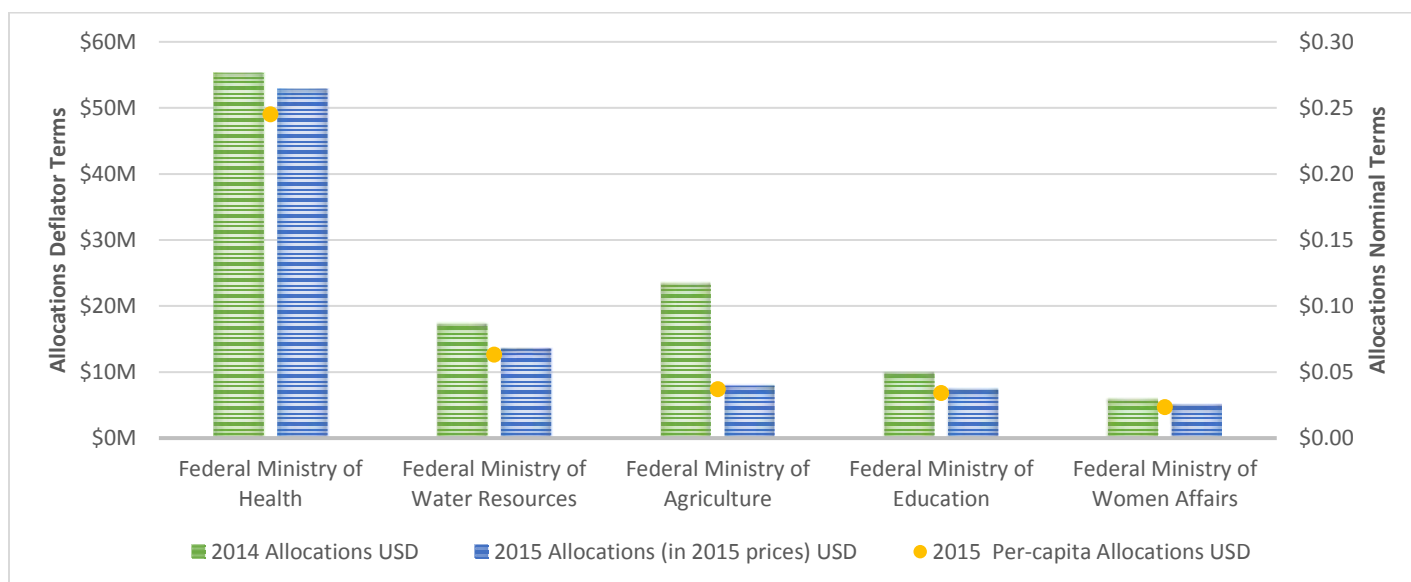

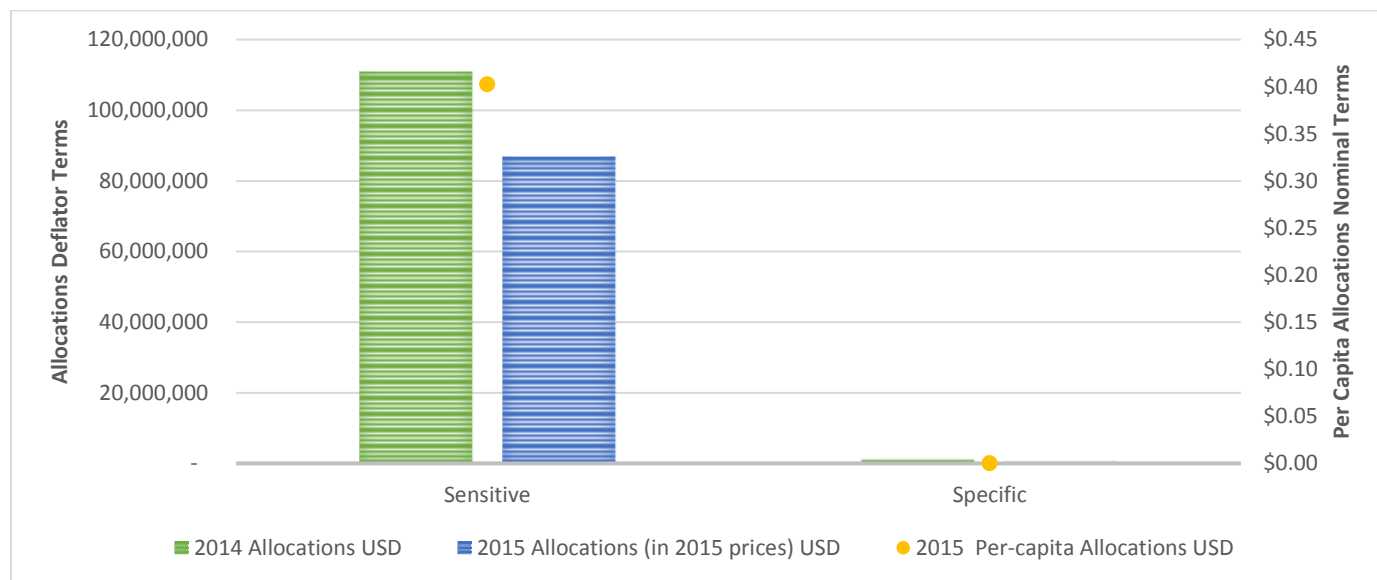

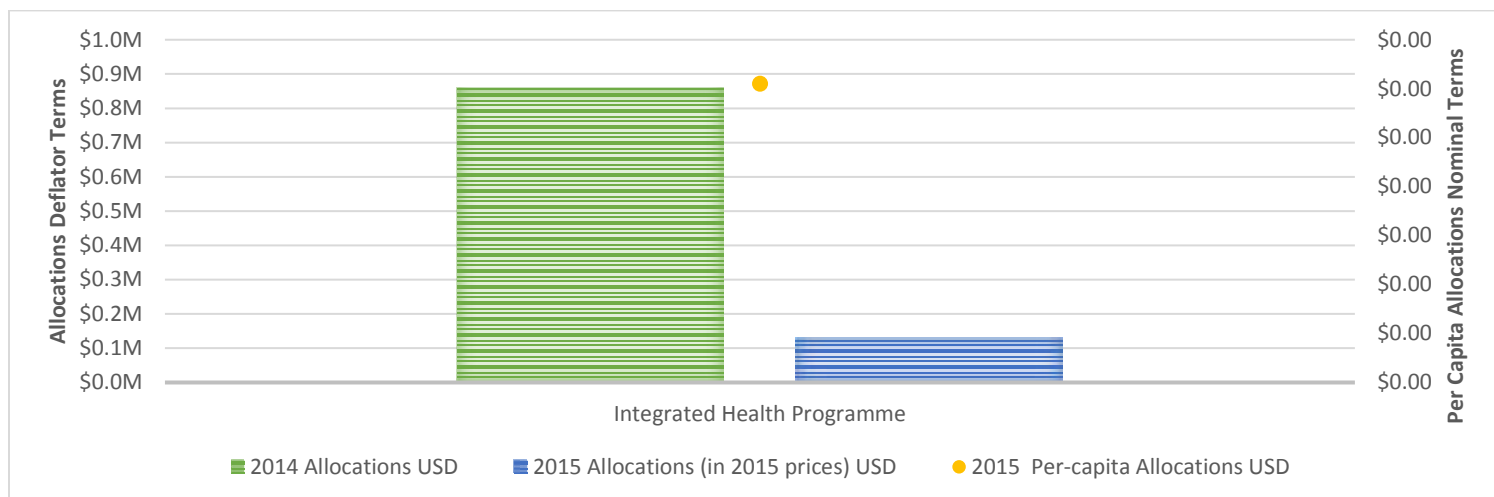

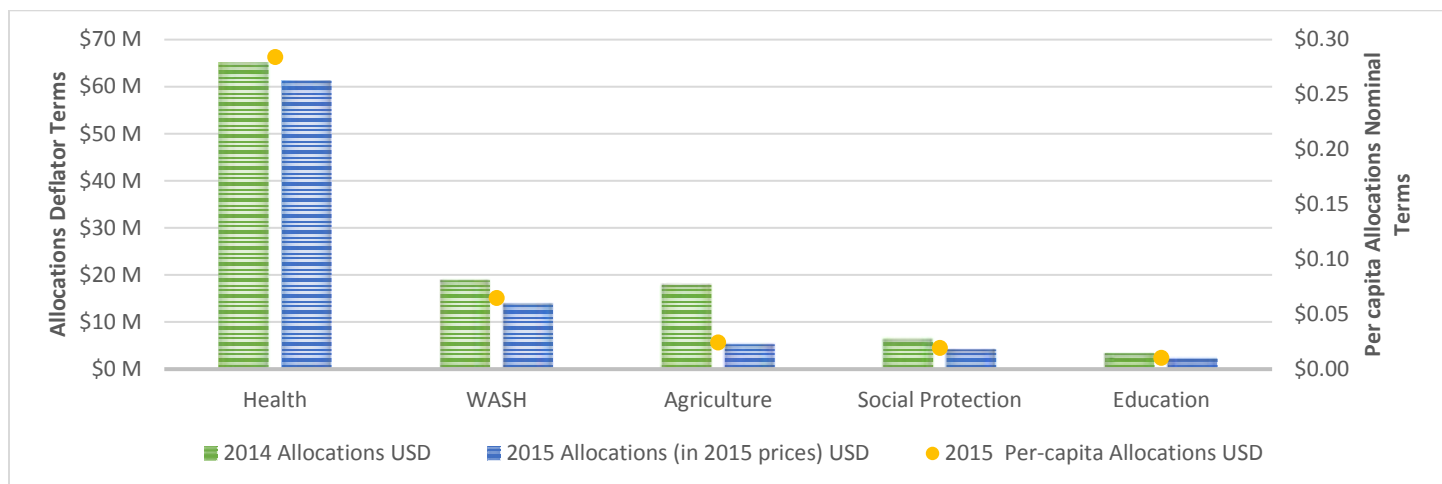

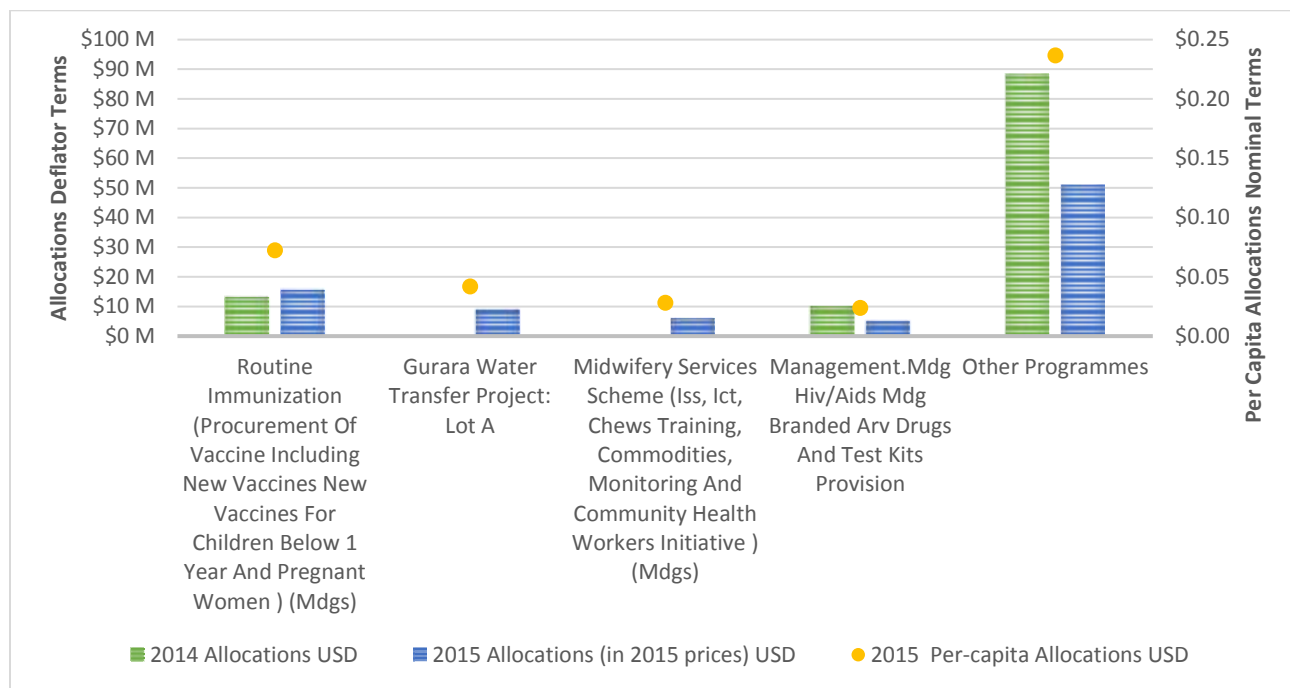
