

# NUTRITION INVESTMENT SNAPSHOT: YEMEN



80 countries are leading a global movement to end malnutrition in all its forms.

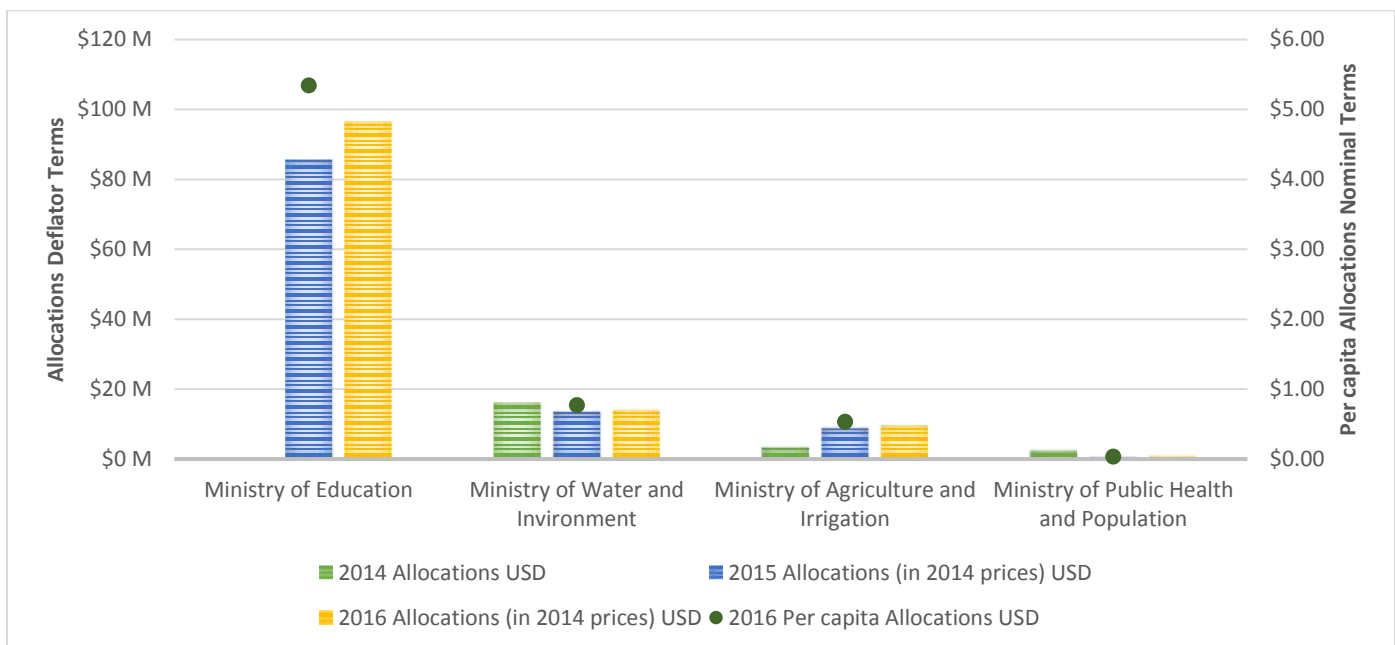
Yemen’s budget analysis data by programme and within each programme. With this information, the 2018 analysis identifies 19 nutrition-relevant programmes and 46 budget line items. Of the 46 budget line items, 26 budget-line items received allocations in 2017. These 26 nutrition-relevant budget line items are overseen by five ministries, departments and agencies (MDAs), which allocated \$6.68 USD per capita in 2016.

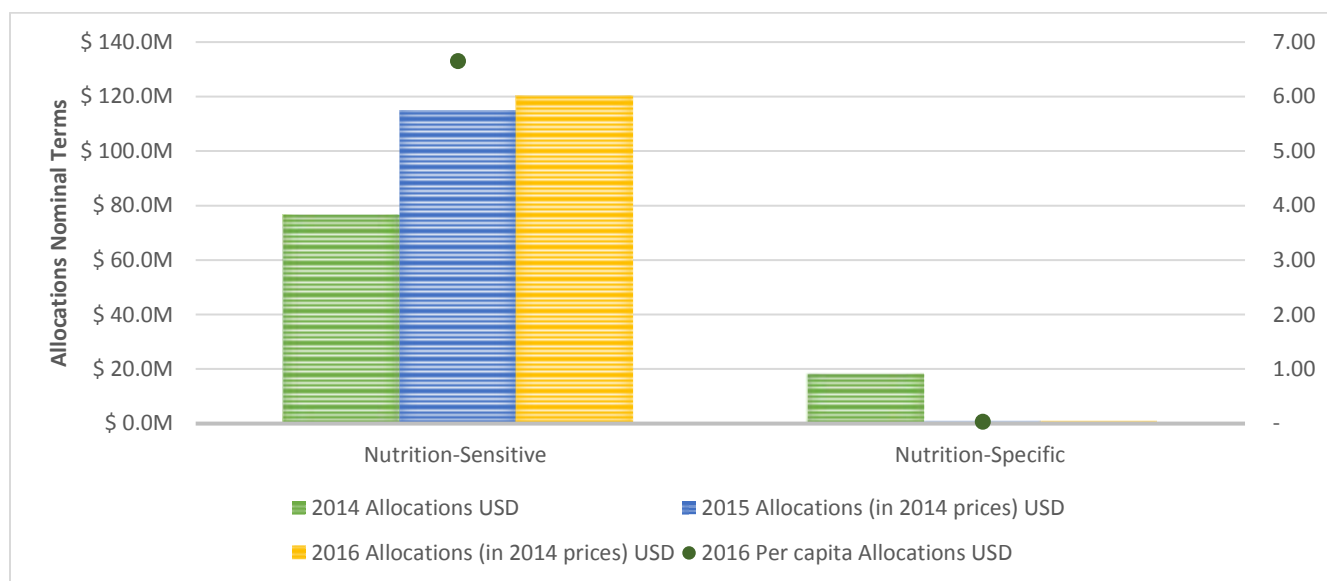

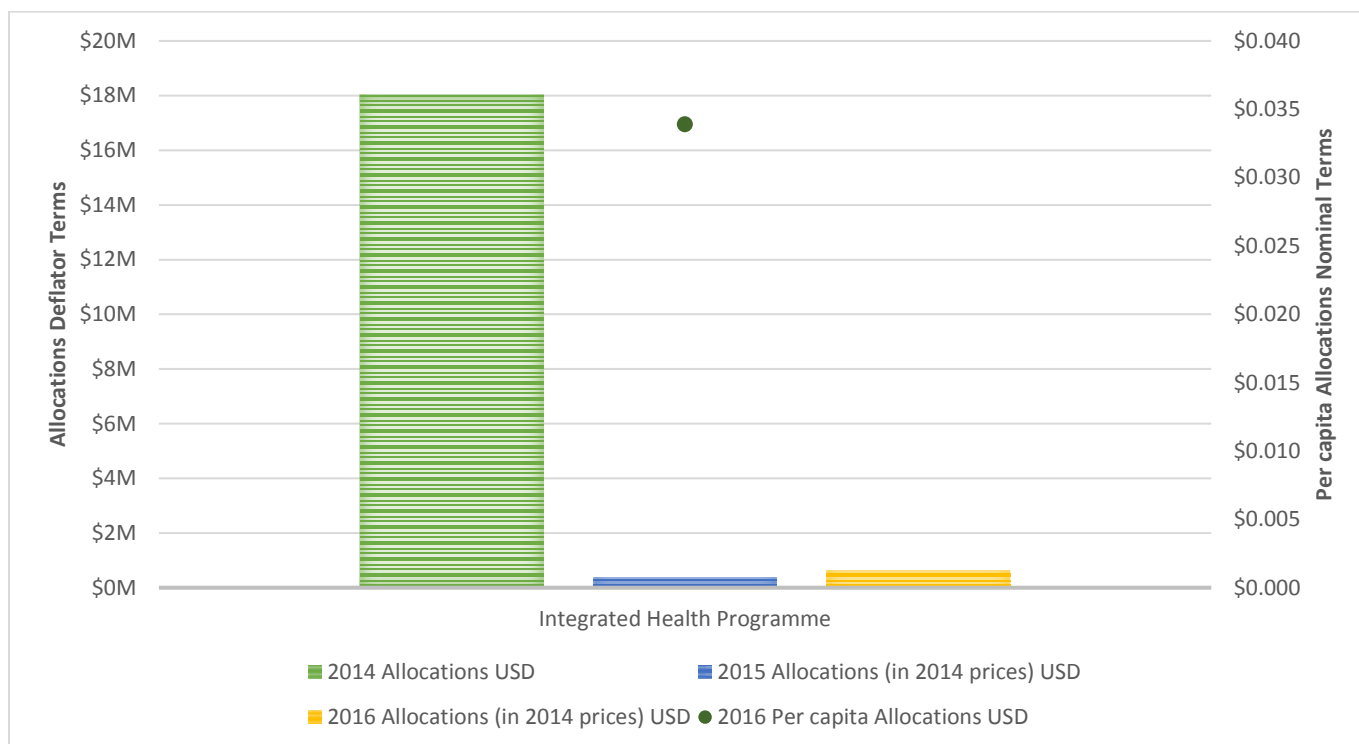

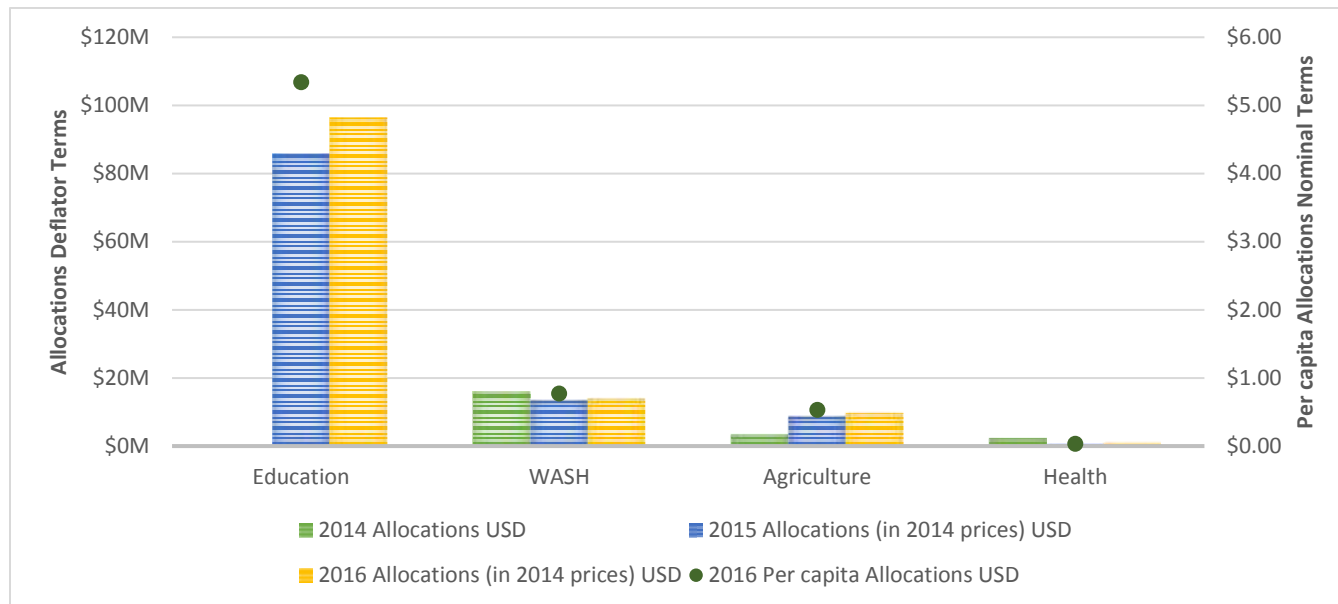
